Professor Mary Chiarella is Professor of Nursing at the University of Sydney. In 2003/04 she was the Chief Nursing Officer, NSW and was a founding member of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Council from 2008-2009. Mary is the NSW nominee on the Nurses and Midwives Board of Australia and will present 'Primary Health Care – A Family Affair'.

Professor Cathrine Fowler holds the Tresillian Chair in Child and Family Health and is a member of the Centre for Midwifery, Child and Family Health at UTS. Cathrine will present the findings of a Trans-Tasman study exploring the implementation of Family Partnership Training and the ability of CFHNS to 'go beyond the notion of being "nice" to being confident to challenge parents about their parenting constructs'.
